Rab (Latin: *Arba*, Italian: *Arbe*, German: *Arbey*) will enchant its visitors with unique nature and sandy beaches.

The island is 22 km (14 mi) long, has an area of 93.6 km² (36 sq mi) and 9328 inhabitants (2011). The highest peak is Kamenjak at 408 m. The southwestern side is covered by one of the last oak forests of the Mediterranean.

Rab has been known as the "Island of Happiness" since the Roman times (Felix Arba in Latin). Saint Martin, the legendary founder of the State of San Marino, originated from here.

The island's beauties have earned Rab numerous prizes - *Silver Flower of Europe, Blue Flower* – not to mention a touristic tradition which now lasts more than one century.
